



Smart-ID users




Mobile-ID users





# Recognition based on eIDAS 1.0

Qualified signature creation:

- Mobile-ID: 2016
- Smart-ID: 2018

Level of Assurance “high”

- Mobile-ID EE: 2016 (EU notified)
- Smart-ID EE: 2019
- Smart-ID LV: 2022...2025 (EU notified...)
- Mobile-ID LT: 2024
- Smart-ID LT: 2024

# EIDAS 2.0

- New trust services to be supported:
  - Electronic Attestation of Attributes
  - Electronic Archiving of digital documents
  - Electronic Ledger
  - Management of remote QSCDs

# EIDAS 2.0

- Wallet related services to be created (not trust services at all)
  - MS wallet conformity assessment body accreditation body
  - MS wallet certification conformity assessment body
  - Competent issuing authority
  - Wallet Issuing CA
  - Relying party registry
  - Relying Party Registrar Certificates issuance
  - Relying Party Access Certificates issuance
  - RP Certificate transparency log operators
  - Qualified signature service provider
  - Qualified electronic attestation of attributes provider

# Other fun from IA's

- EU wide interoperability granted through MS independent wallets
- No non-conformities for any QTSP
- Standards with remarks

# Legal readiness

- No amendments to trust services regulations in any of the Baltic countries regarding eIDAS 2.0 so far!

# EUDIW implementation

- 2025 showed each country a bit differently engaged
  - Latvia makes the most noise as they seem to have got the most funding from LSP's
  - Lithuania is following as good second in promoting the idea that something good comes from EUDIW, that seems to be a shadow of POTENTIAL LSP
  - Estonia has done least noise about it and seems that they are simply not directly paid to do it as much

# EUDIW implementation in 2026

Everyone is clever in their own way

- LV: development partner is being procured already through “competitive dialogue” in the void of competition rules
- LT: Analyses will be done in 2026 by EY to find out how to find out what and if LT should do to get EUDIW
- EE: Procurement foresees to have procurement to find service providers for (maybe 5) different roles

# What is the situation?

- No legal adjustments on MS level
- No real discussions with market if any of the new trust services would really benefit the market
- No unpaid by EC discussions with market what we do with wallets
- No ecosystem impact analyses
- No readiness to take on MS responsibilities (Authentic Sources, Public Services)
- Raising awareness of fraud with digital tools and no plan how to handle it internationally!
